Registration Terms and Conditions

Europe-Asia Economic Summit 2026 (EAES 2026)

1. General

- 1.1. By registering for the Europe-Asia Economic Summit 2026 (“EAES 2026” or the “Event”), you agree to be bound by these Registration Terms and Conditions.
- 1.2. EAES 2026 will take place from 29 June to 1 July 2026 in Davos, Switzerland.

2. Registration and Payment

- 2.1. Registration is available via www.eaesummit.org and is subject to availability.
- 2.2. Registration is confirmed upon full payment of the applicable registration fee.
- 2.3. Accepted payment methods are indicated on the registration platform at the time of booking.
- 2.4. All fees are in Swiss Francs (CHF). Any transaction fees or charges incurred during payment are the responsibility of the registrant.

3. Cancellation, Substitution, and Refund Policy

- 3.1. Cancellations must be submitted in writing to event@easummit.org and will be processed based on the date of receipt.
- 3.2. Refunds are processed as follows:
 - **Cancellations submitted more than 6 months prior to the Event:** Full refund minus a 5% administrative processing fee.
 - **Cancellations submitted between 3 and 6 months prior to the Event:** 50% of the payment will be refunded.
 - **Cancellations submitted less than 3 months prior to the Event:** No refund will be issued.
- 3.3. Exceptions may be considered in cases of force majeure or exceptional personal circumstances, subject to a **5% administrative processing fee**, including but not limited to:
 - Visa Rejection (official rejection letter required)
 - Serious illness or hospitalization of the registrant (official medical documentation required).
 - Death of the registrant or an immediate family member (official documentation required)
- 3.4. Any exceptions to the policy are at the sole discretion of the organizer and reviewed and on a case-by-case basis.
- 3.5. Substitutions are permitted and must be requested in writing at least **30 days prior** to the Event. All registration rights and obligations will transfer to the substitute participant.

4. Event Changes or Cancellations

- 4.1. The organizer reserves the right to modify the Event program, including the schedule, venue, speakers, and sponsors, where necessary.
- 4.2. In the event of a cancellation due to circumstances beyond the organizer's control (e.g., natural disasters, force majeure), registrants will receive a full refund of registration fees paid. The organizer

shall not be liable for any additional costs incurred by registrants, including travel or accommodation expenses.

5. Data Protection and Privacy

5.1. By registering, you acknowledge and agree that your personal data will be processed in accordance with the [Data Policy – Europe-Asia Economic Summit \(EAES\)](#) and applicable data protection laws.

5.2. Registrants' contact information may be shared with third parties directly involved in the organization and delivery of the Event (such as venue operators, badge-printing providers, and technology partners), where necessary for operational purposes and in accordance with applicable data protection laws.

5.3 Registrants' contact information will only be shared with Event partners for Event-related communication and networking purposes where the registrant has provided explicit consent. Registrants may withdraw their consent at any time or opt out of such communications in accordance with the instructions provided.

6. Code of Conduct

6.1. All participants are expected to act professionally and respectfully throughout the Event.

6.2. The organizer reserves the right to remove any participant who engages in disruptive or inappropriate behaviour, without issuing a refund.

7. Liability

7.1. To the fullest extent permitted by law, the organiser accepts no liability for loss, damage, injury, or theft of personal property during the Event.

7.2. Participants are responsible for arranging their own travel and insurance coverage.

7.3. The organizer is not liable for disruptions related to travel, accommodation, or changes to the Event program.

8. Force Majeure

8.1. The organizer shall not be liable for any failure or delay in performance caused by circumstances beyond its reasonable control, including but not limited to natural disasters, pandemics, governmental actions, or acts of terrorism.

9. Governing Law

9.1. These Terms and Conditions are governed by the laws of Switzerland, and any disputes shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Chur, Switzerland.
